Applicants must be:

- Over 18 years of age and a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or an elector of Brympton.
- Alternatively, for a period exceeding twelve months resided within the Parish of Brympton or within three miles of its boundary or occupied as owner or tenant any land or premises therein or had their principal or only place of work there.
- Applicants must not be disqualified for being elected by reason of any disqualification set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972
